Objective

The primary objective of IQAC is

- To assure stakeholders connected with higher education – namely, students, parents, teachers, staff, would-be employers, funding agencies and society in general - of the accountability of the institution for its own quality and probity.

Functions of the IQAC

- Imparting quality education to the masses from the society catering to their diverse needs and fostering global competence among them.
- Promotion of ICT enabled teaching learning process
- Arrangement of feedback response from students, teachers, parents, alumni and other stakeholders
- Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education
- Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement;
- Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes;
- Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality;
- Development of Quality Culture in the institution;
- Performance appraisal mechanism;
- Research sharing and networking with other institutions in India and abroad;
- Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC.
